

- ▶ West Oaks Mall signed a deal with Regal Entertainment to bring our community a premier 14 screen Edwards Theatre multiplex. Edwards West Oaks Stadium 14 will feature all the latest technology and amenities and will anchor the mall's west wing, creating the setting for a new interactive pedestrian plaza surrounded by three new restaurants with outdoor café seating. Construction on Edwards Theatre at West Oaks will begin spring 2012 with a projected opening in Fall 2012.
- ▶ New Developments This Fall: Whataburger and Golden Corral contacted MUD 120 regarding plans to build stores on Hwy 6 at West Park across from Wal-Mart.
- ▶ **Traffic Watch:** Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will begin to add medians on Hwy 6. An additional traffic light will be added on <u>Hwy 6 at Schiller Road</u>, which is between the light at West Park and the West Park overpass bridge.
- Fort Bend County plans to install a traffic light at Beechnut and Winkleman.



Architectural Control Committee

Any external changes to your residence or lot requires submission of a Home Improvement Request Form at least ONE MONTH prior to the date you plan to commence the work. **Work must not begin until you have been given approval by the ACC.**

Recipe Corner

Four Berry Smoothie


- 2 cups vanilla ice cream, softened
- 1 cup fresh or frozen strawberries, sliced
- 3/4 cup fresh or frozen blueberries
- 1/2 cup fresh or frozen raspberries
- 2 tablespoons sugar
- 1/2 cup cranberry juice
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice

Garnishes:

fresh blueberries, raspberries, mint sprigs

Preparation:

Process first 7 ingredients in a blender. Add ice cubes to 4 1/2-cup level; process until smooth stopping once to scrape down sides. Garnish, if desired; serve immediately.
