- Street Parking. With so many residents parking on the street it is critical we adhere to the law and do not inhibit the flow of traffic. It is illegal to park less than 30 feet from a stop sign, within 15 feet of a fire hydrant, or within 15 feet from a curb. Also, you must park facing the direction of traffic. To assist law enforcement in maintaining safety on our streets, we will notify law enforcement when these violations are noted. These offenses may result in a parking ticket from Harris or Fort Bend County law enforcement.
- Lawn Maintenance is a critical component to the aesthetics of our neighborhood. It contributes to our home values and helps set standards for new residents. Let's keep our lawns maintained out of respect to our neighbors and to the value of our community. Help maintain our neighborhood.



Recipe Corner



Ingredients

- 1 package fully cooked bacon slices
- 1 16 oz container sour cream
- 2 cups (8 oz) freshly shredded cheddar cheese
- ½ cup sliced fresh chives
- 2 tsp hot sauce

Directions: Microwave bacon according to package directions until crisp; drain on paper towels. Cool 10 minutes; crumble. Stir together bacon and next 4 ingredients. Cover and chill 1 – 24 hours before serving. Garnish, if desired, with cooked crumbled bacon; sliced fresh chives; freshly cracked black pepper. Serve with chips or crispy warm fries. Store leftovers in refrigerator for up to 7 days.

Pet Owners

There has been a significant increase in stray and feral cats in our neighborhood and some neighbors have complained these cats have attacked their pets.

To protect our pets and prevent our neighborhood from being overrun with litters of stray and feral cats, **please have** your cats spayed or neutered.

There are several programs available in the Houston area that can help to spay and neuter stray and feral cats. Many are proponents of the Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) program and the re-socialization of stray and feral cats for adoption. Go to our website to get a list of area pet agencies and facilities.

Remember— always keep your pets on a leash and pick up waste immediately!
